WORK SESSION MINUTES

1. Dispatch, part time and new hire retirement and seniority agreement
  - a. There is a disparity in that retired dispatchers who return as part time employees can only work 20 hours but other part timers can work 28. This results in new hires having more seniority than those returning to the job. They are requesting the hire date be used to determine seniority, not the hours work. Consensus approves this idea.
2. Hatchery House Historic Designation
  - a. After discussion board in favor of seeking this designation
3. Andersonville Church property split
  - a. Board not in favor of selling 14' to adjacent property owner. Suggest the owner buy the whole property. Supervisor will broach the idea with the adjacent property owner.
4. RCOC federal projects-cities vs. townships
  - a. Unlevel playing field pointed out by the Supervisor of all the projects proposed for 2017 only one is in a Township, all others are in cities. Discussion followed
5. Solar powered lights
  - a. Board favors assisting with 1/3 of the cost to install traffic signals at Grayson on Walton. The suggestion is to use solar powered lights as RCOC has used on Williams Lake Rd at the airport. Board does not favor assisting with the annual maintenance of these traffic signals
