

FARM & FARM ADVENTURE CAMP—2019

Dear Farm and Farm Adventure Camp Parents & Guardians,

Camp is coming and we are eager to head off into a summer filled with our favorite activities, plus an amplified experience with the animals due to a collaboration with MSU Extension's Oakland County 4-H Program. We are excited to offer you a revitalized farm animal encounter and uplifted camp traditions. Our Camp Directors are returning for another year dedicated to making this camp experience memorable for your children. Please review the important details and requests below:



NOTES: When you arrive at camp on the first day, please take the time to confirm with the Camp Director that we have all medical and emergency information as needed and requested by the Wednesday prior to camp. You will need to check your child in every day upon arrival. Campers not signed up for before-care may be signed-in as early as 8:40am on the first day to allow for extra check-in time, the rest of the week please wait until 8:50am. **CHECK-OUT:** Don't forget to sign your child out every day. **You will need a driver's license and the individual must be indicated on your medical form** (parents that are listed are included). BEFORE AND AFTER CARE may be purchased. Those hours begin at 7:30am and extend thru 5:30pm. 3:00pm, and child care will end at 5:30pm every day. There is a \$1.00 per minute late fee if your child has not been picked up by the end of their scheduled day (with a 10-minute grace period).

registered for the appropriate week of camp. IF THE WEATHER DICTATES THAT WE WILL BE INDOORS, you will be informed if we are traveling to a Huron Valley or Waterford High School pool. We do try to make decision by pick-up time the day before, however the weather may change and notification could be during drop-off on Wednesday morning. Parents are more than welcome to meet us at the park; we just ask that parents meet with supervisory staff and sign their children out when they arrive.

OTHER NOTES: It is always suggested that your child wears comfortable, closed shoes that allow them to run and be close to the animals. Your child should wear clothes that are not precious. A rain poncho or extra set of clothes is suggested (this may be left here for the week). Applying sunscreen before camp is recommended (please discuss re-applying sunscreen that is sent with your child). Plan on sending a sack lunch, drink/refillable water bottle and extra snacks (especially if attending before or after care). Also suggested are sunglasses or hat, extra towels and bug spray (optional—we have 2 types at camp that are available). PLEASE LABEL THE WATER BOTTLE, SUNSCREEN AND ALL OTHER PERTINENT ITEMS.
