### **Monthly Paper Recycling**

Waterford Township offers free monthly recycling collection of paper, magazines and cardboard (shipping boxes, cereal boxes, etc., free of food debris and dry.) This service is provided the **second Saturday** of every month from 9am to 1pm in the parking lot at Township Hall 5200 Civic Center Dr. No cost. Waterford Township residents and business owners only, please.

### **GFL Residential Curbside Collection—Holidays, Yard Waste, Bulk Items**

GFL observes the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. If a holiday falls on a weekday, your scheduled service day will be delayed by one day and does include Saturday collection in these cases.

**Yard waste** will be collected on your regular collection day April 5—December 10, 2020.

One **bulk item** per month on your regular collection day, no need to call ahead.
