Subject: Is it too late to apply

Good afternoon, My name is Bill Orlando and our company, DS Partners, owns the **Waterford Towne Center** (with the Kroger) at the intersection of Highland Rd & Crescent Lake Rd. We have a Medical Marihuana Facility tenant who has received the attachment I have attached to this email. It looks as though our site or part of it does conform to the rules and could be considered. The tenant is asking if it is too late to apply? The potential tenant's email to me is below,

TOWNSHIP RESPONSE

This question and those by David Rudoi on 1/5/2021 and 1/7/2021 to which the Township has previously responded is asking the Township to provide an answer that is not possible at this time. The Ordinance does not establish a specified time period or deadline for submission of applications and the point in time when it is too late to apply is dependent on future events.

Section 10-300(b) does prohibit the Township Clerk from accepting an application if it is for a type of facility license that is not available because the number of licenses for that type of facility have already been approved for issuance by the Township Board. Under that standard, it is not too late to apply.

As stated in the Responses to Mr. Rudoi, the date of the first Township Board meeting at which licenses that have been applied for could be approved for issuance for is not known and the last date to submit an application that could be considered with those applications at the same meeting is not known.

The procedures and time periods allowed for administrative completeness and substantive reviews of applications in Section 10-302 of the Ordinance will be followed and applied by the Township in determining what applications for the same type of facility license will be scheduled for consideration at a Township Board meeting.

The Township will not be responding to this same question again.
