## **TOWNSHIP RESPONSES**

As explained in the Township's earlier responses to Questions that are posted on the Medical Marihuana Facility Licensing webpage, the licensing process is not "first come first served", there is no specific due date for submission of applications, and the date the Township Board will make decisions on license applications is unknown. The Township Board has not considered or acted on any applications and all licenses authorized by the Ordinance remain available. Although there is no due date for applications, once the Township Board has approved all of the licenses authorized by the Ordinance for a particular type of facility, the Clerk's office will not accept further applications for that type of license.
